# Winemaker's Flight

## 2017 Sauvignon Blanc

### James Suckling 86 Points

Our 2017 Sauvignon Blanc is produced from fruit grown in Kent County, MD. Beautiful aromas of tangerine and lychee on the nose with hints of grapefruit give way to melon, orange, and tangerine with hints of lime zest.

## 2016 Rosé

### San Francisco Int'l Wine Competition, Silver 2017

Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot grown in Maryland and PA create this Rosé. Bright and fresh with aromas suggesting fresh peaches, strawberries, and lilacs with flavors suggesting fresh cut cantaloupe and salty minerality that make for a pleasant and lingering finish.

## \* 2017 Pinot Gris

Made from grapes grown at Crow Vineyard, this wine has a floral nose with hints of honeysuckle and crushed flint which transitions into a weighty mouthfeel with pear elements, lime rind and a nice acidity.

## 2015 Reserve White Blend

### Atlantic Seaboard Wine Competition, Gold 2018

A blend of Chardonnay, Viognier and Traminette from vineyards in Maryland and PA, this wine was created to share the best of the 2015 harvest with our customers. Fresh and vibrant aromas suggesting lime, tangerine, and floral notes. This wine is full and rounded in the mouth, backed up by flavors suggesting stone-fruit, peach, and melon.

## 2015 Vintner's Select White Blend

Using grapes grown in Maryland, this lively wine is a blend of Traminette, Vidal Blanc and Chardonnay. Aromas suggesting pear, elderflower, honeycrisp apple and spring grass. The palate is packed with flavors suggesting rose petals, orange peel, river rock and pineapple.

## \* 2014 Barbera

Aromas suggesting dark cherry, vanilla, nutmeg, and almond extract. It is ruby in color and has flavors suggesting dried strawberries, violets, white peppercorn, and plum with a long finish and soft tannins.

## 2014 Merlot

Rich and bold featuring aromas of black cherry, dried tobacco, rosemary, and dark chocolate. It is well structured with medium tannins, flavors of black cherry, raspberry and hints of mint in the finish. Grapes from Maryland and PA were used.

## \* 2015 Sparkling Vidal Blanc

Made using the traditional méthode champenoise, this wine exhibits aromas of nectarine, pear, green apple and baker's yeast. Flavors of lemon zest and honey notes with hints of mango.

## \* 2016 Vidal Blanc

Our 2016 Vidal Blanc has aromas suggesting fresh pineapple, lilac, confectioner's sugar, vanilla bean, and melon. The palate has beautiful weight, slight sweetness, fruit flavors suggesting nectarines and peaches, and wonderful balance.

## 2016 Rosé

### San Francisco Int'l Wine Competition, Silver 2017

Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot grown in Maryland and PA create this Rosé. Bright and fresh with aromas suggesting fresh peaches, strawberries, and lilacs with flavors suggesting fresh cut cantaloupe and salty minerality that make for a pleasant and lingering finish.

## 2015 Unoaked Chardonnay

### Maryland Comptroller's Cup, Gold 2017

Maryland and PA grapes were used in this Chardonnay fermented and aged entirely in stainless steel. Aromas suggesting lime, honeydew melon, hints of peach, slate, and hints of banana. It has bright acidity and flavors suggesting juicy apple, honey, cantaloupe, and cream.

## 2014 Chardonnay

### San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition, Silver 2017, Maryland Comptroller's Cup, Silver 2016 & Int'l Women's Wine, Silver 2016

Aged in french oak and created with balance in mind to please all palates. This wine, made from Maryland and PA grapes, has aromas suggesting peaches, vanilla bean and pie crust.

## 2015 Vintner's Select Red Blend

Comprised of Barbera and Nebbiolo from vineyards in Maryland and PA, this cherry hued wine has aromas suggesting blackberries, cedar, cinnamon, cloves and vanilla. It has a soft, easy drinking mouthfeel.

## \* 2014 Barbera Reserve

Crimson colored with aromas suggesting cherries and plums, vanilla bean, and spice. On the palate, it has robust structure and tannin with a smooth finish and is supported by flavors suggesting black cherry, raspberry and strawberries.

## 2015 Reserve Red Blend

Our growing partners in PA provided the grapes for this wonderful blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. Deep in color with aromas suggesting raspberry, white peppercorn, crushed gravel and mint. On the palate, it has good structure and tannin throughout and is supported by flavors suggesting blueberry, plum, vanilla, and espresso.

## \* 2015 Sparkling Vidal Blanc
